



Why are we using OpenID?

OpenID allows users to have a single login for several websites. For instance, you can register on IYC and use the same account on other websites with an OpenID login, such as Google, Yahoo, Oxfam, and many others.

If you already have an OpenID, feel free to use it on our website (You will have to enter the whole OpenID identifier). If not, you will be able to create one thanks to European Schoolnet, who manages the portal.

On the OpenID server you will be able to access many services at once:

- Modify your profile,
- Manage your account,
- Request a new password

How does it work?

OpenID is a little different from what you may be used to when you log in on other communities. Instead of inserting your user name and password into the website you wish to log into, you first need to register on the OpenID server and then go back to the portal you are visiting and where you wish to log in.

How to create an OpenID

STEP 1

Go to <http://water.chemistry2011.org> and click on "Create an account"

<u>Username</u>	<input type="text"/>	Only letters and numbers, minimum 6 characters.
First name	<input type="text"/>	You will need to remember your Username and password to log in!!
Last name	<input type="text"/>	
Email address	<input type="text"/>	Enter a valid email address, this will be used should you forget your password.
<u>Password</u>	<input type="text"/>	Choose a strong one! Minimum 6 characters.
Confirm password	<input type="text"/>	It should contain a mix of digits, uppercase and lowercase letters.

STEP 2
